The next time the kids are in the back seat and hungry, remember these healthy snacks that are a much better choice than chips and a soda. Try picking up some pretzels, whole wheat crackers, peanuts, fruit juice, low-fat chocolate milk, granola bars, or frozen yogurt!

LMMS REMINDERS:

Each child's family is provided a **Snack List** for their child/ren's class, in advance. Occasionally, changes need to be made to ensure we have enough juice/milk or to accommodate for an over abundance of a particular snack item. Please remember to look at the **"snack note reminder"** attached to your child's lunch bag to be sure you are sending in the correct items and only on the day that you have been assigned.

As we get closer to summer, mosquitoes and other biting insects will be in abundance in our area. **Please look for long-lasting insect-repelling products and sunscreen that can be applied before dropping your child off at school.** We can only apply sunscreen at school if it's required for medical reasons and must have a doctor's note. Feel free to send a hat for your child to wear for extra protection and make sure to label all items that are sent to school.

Please refer to the parents handbook regarding supplies needed for your child. If the weather does not permit outside time, there are supplies your child keeps in their cubby as an option for an indoor activity such as a coloring book, crayons, pencil box, etc.

Snack assignments are planned to feed your child's entire class for 2 days. Please make sure you bring enough to feed all children in your child's class (26 in each Primary class, 16 in 2's) and we want to avoid orange, cranberry and dark grape juice.
