### LMMS REMINDERS:

**Please be aware that if your child is signed up to bring in a perishable snack** (ie: bananas, milk, etc.), **bring it on the date assigned** to ensure that it is in good condition for students and able to "keep" for the two days it is intended to be served.

Mosquitoes and other biting insects are in abundance in our area, please look for long-lasting insect-repelling products and sunscreen that can be applied <u>before</u> dropping your child off at school. We can only apply these products at school if they are required for medical reasons and must have a doctor's note. Otherwise, your child will need to be able to apply it to themselves. For this, we recommend a roll-on or stick-type products. Feel free to send a hat for your child to wear for extra protection and make sure to label all items that are sent to school.

If the weather does not permit outside time, your child has the option to use their coloring book and crayons for an indoor activity. Please change out these items regularly, especially during the summer months, to ensure your child has what they need.

Please encourage your child(ren) to stay on the sidewalk when entering and exiting the school. We take pride in the safety of our children and in the maintenance of our landscaping.

**Snack assignments are planned to feed your child's entire class for 2 days.** Please make sure you bring enough to feed all children in your child's class (25 in each Primary class, 16 in 2's) and we want to **avoid orange, cranberry and dark grape juice.**
